- Does IT support scale as we add staff, locations, or systems?
- Are IT decisions aligned with business priorities, not just emergencies?

# Understanding Your Results

## **Reactive IT (0–3 checked)**

IT is stable, proactive, and aligned with the business. Systems are maintained, risks are managed, and leadership has confidence in their technology environment.
